PORTLAND, April 10.—(UP)—Governor Charles A. Brown today called for a "stiffened attitude" against enemy aliens and urged Oregonians to rededicate themselves to the complete destruction of Japan.

He suggested that federal officers effect the immediate removal of all Japs from the Pacific coast. "Put them to work in the best fields of the Rocky mountain states where they can provide much needed sugar in the fields of much needed sugar," he said.
