Jews In Berlin Are Assessed For Damage To Own Property

Berlin, Nov. 13 - (AP) - Assessments up to 150,000 marks \$60,000-were levied on individual wealthy Berlin Jews today to repair the damage done last week by Aryan window smashers and store wreckers seeking revenge for the fatal shooting of a German diplomat.

Those assessed were told the assessments did not exempt them from also con-tributing to the 1,000,000,000 mark (\$400,000,000) penalty decreed on German Jews Saturday for the murder of Ernst Von Rath, the Paris embassy secretary.

One person who was summoned to the meeting at which assess-ments were presented, estimated the number of Jews convoked by the president of the Jewish com-munity "on government, orders" at about 100

These wealthy members of the Jewish community received special delivery letters summoning them to a meeting in the Jewish Bretherhood House on Kurfuer-atenstrasse, late this morning. The summonses were signed by President Stahl, who stated he was acting on government instructions.

Through the Jewish community tonight ran word that raids in which Jewish men were arrested throughout Eaturday night had ended. It also became known that a number of those arrested returned home today. Those released were over 30 years old.

Information indicated that the arrests had been made on a quota basis for each city in Germany. Berlin's total was said to have been 2000 and apparently was reached early foday.

The bulk of Jewish wealth was believed to be in real estate, some of which might have to be sold to satisfy demands. Jewish wealth in greater Germany, including Austria and Sudetenland, was estimated at about 8,000,000,000 marks (\$3,200,000,00) making the fine one-eighth the total wealth

wealth.

What will have to be sold and the degree of property ownership remaining for Jews will depend upon how the government levies the penalty among various classes; How the fine will be collected has not yet been disclosed.

One wealthy Jew, after hearing of the decrees which imposed the fine and prohibited Jews from conducting business after next Jan. 1. said: "yesterday I was rich; today I am a pauper."

Weakness on the stock exchange Saturday was the first signal of what may happen to markets if wholesale selling by Jews is necessary. Bank stocks suffered along with industrials and financial circles attributed the weakness to unloading by Jews in view of the new anti-semitic laws.

Small Merchants Hard Hit Small Jewish merchants will be especially hard hit, for on top of losses through looting and destruction of their properties in widespread anti-semitic demonstrations. 

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

Berlin, Nov. 13,—(UP)—Propaganda Minister Paul Joseph Goebbels today asserted that the Paris assassination of a minor German diplomat-an act or a minor German diplomat—an act that unleashed Nazism's worst anti-semitic terror—was a Jewish plot to stir up trouble between Germany and the Western Powers.

The propaganda minister spoke at winter relief demonstration in Ber-

Jews, he asserted, guilty of the shooting in Paris of Ernst Von Rath, third secretary of the German embassy, because all Jewry throughout the worked against the Reich.

"Now they must suffer the consequences of their manifold crimes," Goebbels asserted.

"The purpose of the shooting of the German diplomat was to bring about a worsening of relations between Germany and the Western Powers, and thus again disturb the international atmosphere which has been clearing.

"They (the Jews) have been spared
all too long because of German
generosity and good nature. Let there

now be an end to it.
"The Jewish problem will be solved

very shortly in accordance with the will of the German people."

Goebbela asserted that the drastic decrees, such as Thursday's reign of terrorism that extended to every part of the nation with unestimation destruction, was in accord with the demands of the people. The Nazi theory, he said, demands that government action always must be distated by the people themselves.

"The people want this and we are only carrying out the peoples' will,"

he shouted.


